

CLASSROOM SUPPLY LISTS 22-23

Ms. Chmura - Pre-School (not required but would be very appreciated)

- 1 box of tissues
- Disinfectant wipes
- Sensory materials (dried beans, rice, pasta)
- 2 reusable grocery bags for your child to use
- 1 pack of plastic spoons or forks
- 1 pack of paper plates

Ms. Ahrensdorf – Kindergarten

- 1 pack washable fat Crayola markers
- 1 pack **black fine tip** dry erase markers
- 1 pack Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue
- 1 box no. 2 pencils (*last names A-K*)
- 1 box plastic sandwich baggies (*last names L-Z*)

Ms. Jillson – Grade 1

- 1 Box of crayons
- 1 container Clorox wipes
- 1 box tissue
- 1 package of markers
- 1 package colored pencils
- 1 fabric tote bag for holding picture books (the kind available at grocery stores for shopping will work)

Mrs. McMillan – Grade 2

- 2 boxes tissues
- 2 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 2 bottles of hand soap

Mrs. Taylor – Grade 3

- 1 box Crayola crayons (24 ct)
- 1 box Crayola colored pencils (12)
- 1 container of cap erasers
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 pencil box
- 1 box Crayola Classic, Fine line markers

Each student should have a dictionary to use at home and a ruler with inch and centimeter reading.

Ms. Shearer - Grade 4

Pencils (to share with the class)

1 pack of colored pencils

1 pack of markers

1 pack of crayons

Pencil top erasers (to share with the class)

Pencil box or bag (for in desk)

4 wide ruled spiral notebooks

One plastic pocket folder (to be used for daily homework folder - paper folders do not last)

Scissors (optional)

For classroom use: Dry erase markers, 1 box of tissues, 1 container disinfectant wipes, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 1 black sharpie (or black permanent marker), 1 pack of 3x3 sticky notes

Ms. Norwood – Grade 5

1 1-inch, basic 3-ring, hard-covered binder

1 package of 5 binder divider tabs

1 pencil box (large enough to hold the small items for individual student use)

1 box of Kleenex

1 container of disinfecting wipes

1 reusable water bottle to be kept in the classroom

2 fine tip dry erase markers (*optional*)

2 3X3 inch Post it note pads (*optional*)

1 package of 4X6 or 3X5 lined index cards (*optional*)

One 2 inch binder
