

## CLASSROOM SUPPLY LISTS 24-25

### Ms. Chmura - Pre-School (not required but would be very appreciated)

- 1 box of tissues
- Disinfectant wipes
- 2 reusable grocery bags for your child to use
- 1 pack of paper plates
- 1 bottle of hand soap (last names A-K)
- 1 bottle of bubbles or sidewalk chalk (last names L-Z)

### Ms. Ahrensdorf - Kindergarten

Kindergarten is currently very well-stocked with our smaller everyday items! **IF** you'd like to contribute *any* of the following "bigger" items, *any quantity* would be much appreciated!

- 4 oz. cans of Play-Doh
